

Courtesy notice to City of Beverly Hills residents regarding Beverly Hills City Council Study Session to discuss operational changes at Virginia Robinson Gardens

This is a courtesy notice to inform you that the City of Beverly Hills City Council will discuss the Los Angeles County proposal to implement operational changes at Virginia Robinson Gardens (1008 Elden Way, Beverly Hills, CA 90210) that may impact your neighborhood. The virtual City Council Study Session will take place on <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>December 7, 2021 at 2:30 PM</u>. Participation information is provided below.

Please note, this is not a City of Beverly Hills project, and the City of Beverly Hills does not have final decision making authority on the project. At the City Council Study Session, the City Council will discuss the proposed operational changes and may provide staff with direction on future participation in the County review process. The proposed modifications at the Virginia Robinson Gardens include:

- Days open to the public: Monday to Sunday (7 days a week);
- Hours for public use: 9:30 a.m. to sunset;
- Number of patrons in attendance: With advance reservations, up to 200 visitors per day, spread throughout the day for either tours, meetings seminars/classes, events or commercial filming (video only, no motion picture) or a combination of these activities;
- Types of events: In addition to existing events, consider family ceremonies such as weddings;
- Special uses: up to 24 special use events a year/approximately 2 per month.

by the City Council. Written comments should identify the Agenda Item Number or Topic in the subject line of the email. In order to be read at the meeting, written comments will be allowed with a maximum of words, which corresponds to approximately 3 minutes of speaking time.

If a comment is received after the agenda item is heard, it will not be a part of the record. Public comment via video conference will be 3 minutes per each individual comment, subject to City Council discretion.
