

PROJECT NOTICE

Dear Residents,

The City will be performing fire hydrant flushing in your service area starting May 16, 2022 through May 20, 2022.

Purpose:
Preventative water system maintenance to ensure high quality drinking water.

What to Expect:

- Minimal impacts to on-street parking.
- No impact to traffic flow.
- Minimal noise.
- Fire hydrant flushing may take between 2-4 hours to conduct.
- Vehicle equipment and trucks on site.
- A temporary reduction in water pressure and/or discoloration of the water.
- These conditions are normal during flushing activities and are only temporary. Please check your drinking, cooking, and laundry water before using.
- To clear your water lines, simply turn on your cold water tap or outside hose bib and let it run until the water is clear.

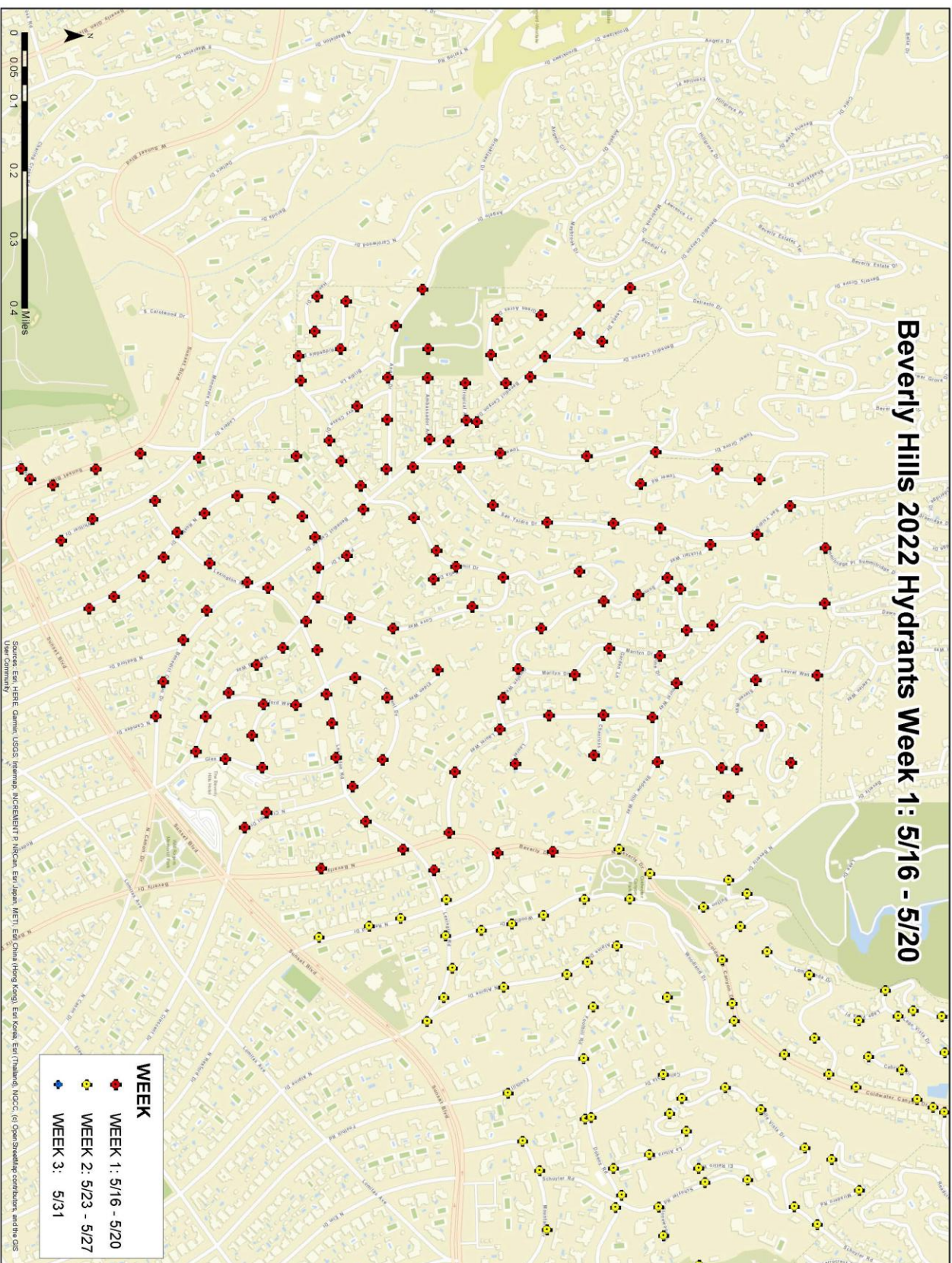
