

Military Equipment Use

2022 Annual Report

Pursuant to Government Code Section 7072(a), a law enforcement agency that receives approval for a military equipment use policy pursuant to Section 7071 shall submit an annual report to the governing body. The report shall include:

1. A summary of how the military equipment was used and the purpose of its use.
2. A summary of any complaints or concerns received concerning the military equipment.
3. The results of any internal audits, any information about violations of the military equipment use policy, and any actions taken in response.
4. The total annual cost for each type of military equipment, including acquisition, personnel, training, transportation, maintenance, storage, upgrade, and other ongoing costs, and from what source funds will be provided for the military equipment in the calendar year following submission of the annual military equipment report.
5. The quantity possessed for each type of military equipment.
6. If the law enforcement agency intends to acquire additional military equipment in the next year, the quantity sought for each type of military equipment.

Government Code Section 7072 (a)(1) – How the equipment was used and the purpose of its use

The Beverly Hills Police Department had over 40 deployments of Military Equipment from May 2022 to present. Reasons for deployment included:

- High Risk Traffic Stops
- Burglary Investigations
- Persons with a firearm
- Persons with a knife
- Barricaded suspect
- Combative suspect
- Search Warrant
- Robbery suspects
- Traffic accidents
- National Night Out
- Dui Checkpoint
- BOLD
- Golden Globes

Military Equipment serves several purposes to include but not limited to:

- Officer safety
- Enhancing public safety
- De-escalation
- Providing police personnel with the ability to more quickly respond to emergency calls for service.
- Providing less lethal methods to safely extract a suspect or safely detain a suspect who poses a risk of violence.
- Allows officers to confront a potentially armed or dangerous suspect from a longer distance.
